

Subject: Energy Conservation Awareness Week in DTL (A Report)

With the approval of competent authority Energy Conservation Awareness Week was held **from 17.10.07 to 24.10.07** in six different office complexes of DTL as per the programme circulated vide letter no. 67 dt. 12.10.07 (Page 3/Cr). The week was **inaugurated by Hon'ble ED (A)** on 17.10.07 at conference hall Shakti Sadan. In his inaugural speech ED (A) emphasized the need of Energy Conservation and use of more and more new and Renewable Energy Resources. One framed poster title "How can we conserve Energy?" was presented by EO (EE & REM) to ED (A) for display in the conference hall of Shakti Sadan.

The above programme was followed by five more programmes of one hour duration from 4.00 PM to 5.00 PM **held at conference hall DPCL, RPH, Jhandewalan office, 220 KV Substation Park Street, 220 KV Substation Lodhi Road and SLDC Building** which were attended by nearly **200 employees** of DTL. **The highlights of this one hour awareness programme were as under :**

3. Presentation on Solar Water Heater indicating benefits, subsidy and loan scheme was presented by Manager (T) EE & REM-I.

4. QA session were also held in which the doubts of participants were clarified by Manager (T) EE & REM and DGM (T) EE & REM.

5. Before the one hour awareness programme were concluded, pledge on Energy Conservation was administered to the participants by DGM (T) EE & REM.

6. Banners were displayed at prominent places in the buildings where the Awareness Programme was scheduled.

7. Photographer and banquets at Shakti Sadan was arranged by PRO.

8. The Energy Conservation Awareness Week in DTL was a big success in which the officers and staff of DTL participated actively. The programme was basically for non-technical staff of DTL.
