Sub: - Scheme for promotion of Solar Water Heating System through Rebate / Incentive to Domestic / Household Consumers in Delhi.

Sir,

This is in continuation to Power Department Letter No.F.11 (149)/2006-Power/P-II/83 dated 12.01.07 on the above noted subject where the approval of the Cabinet for promotion of Solar Water Heating System through Rebate / Incentive Scheme to the Domestic / Household Consumers in Delhi has been conveyed.

The **detail procedure** for release of rebate /incentive to the domestic consumers for promotion of Solar Water Heating System will be as under:

1. The domestic consumers should purchase the Solar Water Heating System from the BIS/ MNRE approved manufactures/suppliers/authorized dealers.
2. The authorized dealer /supplier should sale the Solar Water Heating System to the consumers on subsidized rate i.e. after reducing the price of the System by the rebate/ incentive amount of Rs.6000/- on production of photocopy of last paid electricity bill.
3. The dealer/supplier should send consolidated claim of the rebate /incentive passed on to the consumers for getting it reimbursed from EE & REM centre of DTL along with following documents on monthly basis:-
 - (i) Bill of Solar Water Heater purchased by consumer
 - (ii) Photocopy of last paid bill of electricity of consumer
 - (iii) Certificate of installation and commissioning of Solar Water Heating system by authorized dealer/manufacture/supplier

4. DTL should reimburse the rebate/incentive amount within 15 days after receipt of the claim. However, before making reimbursement of subsidy amount to supplier/dealer, the representative of DTL should verify the commissioning of Solar Water Heater System.
5. The amount shall be released by the EE & REM centre of DTL to the authorized dealer / manufacturer / supplier through ECS only out of the Energy Conservation Fund.
6. The copy of the Electricity bill along with the installation report of the Solar Heater will be sent to the Distribution Company for printing on the electricity bill of the consumer that “**Solar Water Heater installed**” in order to avoid the duplicacy of the rebate claim by the same consumers subsequently. This will also help DTL to monitor the impact of the scheme on Energy conservation and benefit derived by the consumer from the installation of the Solar Water Heater for evaluation of the implementation of the Scheme.
7. DTL should maintain a computerized database of all such consumers getting the rebate/incentive under the above scheme.
8. In order to ensure that the full rebate/incentive of Rs.6000 is passed on to the consumer by the authorized dealer/manufacturer, DTL should make the public aware of the approximate cost of the Solar Water Heating System of various make and capacity and the name of authorized dealer/manufacturer /supplier in Delhi through awareness campaign and by distributing the leaflets in the customer care centres/cash counters of Discoms.
9. Those domestic consumers who have already installed the system after the scheme formally launched on 22.12.2006 (while showcasing the achievements of Power Sector in Pragati Maidan) should be given the incentive/rebate directly by DTL through ECS after verifying the actual installation and on production of documents listed above in para-3

These issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
